Mask Wear:

Masks are mandatory. Once a racer has started race they can remove their mask. Once the race is complete they must put their mask back on.

Race Line-Up:



For lining up prior to race start. Single file lines, even if you're in a group/family. Once race starts you may run next to your group/family but keep space with other patrons.

Social Distancing:

All racers must stay as distanced as possible while in the start/finish areas.



Vendors:

Vendors will be available after the race. Please social distance, wear your mask and obey all signage for lines.

BONEYARD SUPPLEMENTAL RACE DETAILS

PACKET PICK-UP DAYS: NOVEMBER 16-17, 1000-1400 @ THE LANDING COMMUNITY CENTER

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BRING THEIR RACE BIB & FACE MASK WITH THEM TO ENTER THE EVENT AREA. THERE WILL BE NO RACE-DAY CHECK-IN.

PACKET PICK-UP

Packet pick-up will take place on base at The Landing Community Center (5555 Ironwood St.) on Monday, November 16 and Tuesday, November 17 from 1000-1400. There will be NO race-day packet pick-up, so if you cannot make it during these dates please email us to make alternate arrangements. Your packet will contain all day-of information, as well as your t-shirt and race day bib. There will not be race day check-in area, so your bib will act as your "ticket" into the race area. All race participants must bring their bib with them to enter AMARG on the day of the race. If you included children in your registration, they will not receive t-shirts but will have their own bibs included inside your packet. Please ensure you have the correct number of bibs. Children ages 10 & older are required to wear a mask.

PARKING

Parking will be available at the Med Group parking lots (4175 S. Alamo Ave.) Please arrive early to ensure you find a good parking spot. There will not be a shuttle into the AMARG area, so please prepare to walk into the event area. The entrance to AMARG is located adjacent to the Med Group at the corner of S. Alamo Ave. & Picacho St. The AMARG gate will be open to entrants at 0600.

5K COURSE

The 5k portion of the race will feature a staggered start time to aid in maintaining social distance. Upon entering the event area, follow signs to the 5k gathering area. Please follow all rules for lining up prior to the race start, and keep in a single file line even if you're in a group/family. Once the race starts, you may run next to your group/family but keep space with other patrons. You will depart the starting line after the 10k runners have all left. Please begin moving towards the Starting Line at 0745, as the first group will leave the line at 0800. There will be volunteers and signs throughout the course pointing you in the correct direction.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

In an effort to make this event as safe as possible, COVID guidelines will be strictly enforced. Masks are mandatory and can only be removed after you have left the Starting Line and until you have completed the race. There will be hand-washing stations located throughout the event area. Racers must social distance when congregating around the Start/Finish lines, and abide by all signage posted throughout the event area. If you are not feeling well in any way, we ask that you not come to the race.

OTHER RULES & DETAILS

OTHER RULES: Do not veer off of the course path at any point during the race. Do not touch or hang from any of the aircraft. Photography is allowed. The race will not be officially timed, so please plan accordingly if you wish to time yourself. No pets allowed.

PLEASE BRING: Your race bib, face masks, water, sunscreen, hand sanitizer, snacks, DoD ID/identification, cash and/or card for vendor purchases, and anything else to make sure you are comfortable during the event.

KEY TAKEAWAYS:

- NO bag drop area on-site, only bring what you can carry with you throughout the race.
- Base passes must be secured 24-48 hours prior to the event.
- Park at the Med Group and walk over to the race entrance at the AMARG gate.
- Wear your mask the entire time (only remove your mask when you begin the race and put it back on when you finish the race).
- Bibs and masks are MANDATORY for entrance into AMARG.
- Queue along the fence line of the AMARG entrance gate (south of the Med Group) for metal detector security checks by Security Forces at the AMARG gate.
- Social distance while waiting and during the race.
- Once you finish the race, grab a snack to-go and head back to your vehicle.
- North Wilmot gate will be open for exiting the event.
