All units funded for CY23

The installation Community Cohesion Coordinator (C3) can confirm your allocation, which is based on unit end strength.

CY23 Allocations

Participation Costs

\$13.50 per person

Activity, supplies, equipment rentals, etc.

Funds CANNOT be used for prizes.

Food Allowance

\$5.00 per person

One meal and one non-alcoholic beverage

Meal must be used in conjunction with a UNITE event.

UNITE funds CANNOT be used to augment holiday parties on or off the installation. Units are responsible for expenses that exceed the allotted amount. UNITE funds CANNOT be combined with Unit Enhancement Funds or SM&W Funds.

Private Organization funds may be used. Unused UNITE funds will be returned to AFSVA.

Paying for UNITE

Your installation C3 will make UNITE payments on your behalf via a purchasing card you must ensure budget limits are maintained at all times.

Final attendance count is due at least 72 hours prior to your on-base event and will be used to invoice meals planned at FSS facilities. If the actual number is greater than what was planned, you will be invoiced for the greater number. Off-base attendance requirements may differ.

Host your UNITE event in three easy steps!

1. Event Proposal

Complete the Event Proposal Form at least **three weeks** prior to your event. To discuss objectives, event ideas, and more contact your installation C3.

Types of Events

Requests require prior approval through the Air Force Services Activity (AFSVA) and may take up to three weeks, so plan accordingly.

1. Ready to Execute (RTE)

RTE programs are standard package deals that are easy to implement. FSS related events keep funds on the installation and should be considered first. All events need to be submitted for funding approval.

2. Unit Developed Program (UDP)

Squadron leaders are given the discretion to create UDPs that capitalize on opportunities available in the local area.

3. Free/Volunteer

Charitable work provides a cost effective team building activity that allows co-workers to see each other in a new light and to make a real difference in your community. Free events do not need approval but we still need to capture the information.

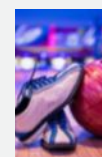
